RECYCLE OFTEN:



Metal Cans

Steel, tin & aluminum soda, vegetable, fruit & tuna cans



Plastic Bottles & Containers #1-5 & 7

Natural and pigmented plastic narrow-neck containers. Milk bottles, water bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, bleach bottles, etc.



Paper

Brown paper bags, non-confidential, office paper, newspaper, magazines



Paper Cardboard, Dairy & Juice Containers

Food and beverage cartons such as milk, soup and broth. Lids must be removed



Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard

Corrugated cardboard, construction paper, Kraft paper, cereal boxes, shoeboxes or similar

RECYCLE RIGHT:

Things you can do to ensure quality material is recycled:



DO NOT INCLUDE: Food waste, plastic bags, or polystyrene foam cups & containers

RECYCLE RIGHT CONTINUED:

DO NOT INCLUDE:

- Aerosol cans
- All liquids
- Animals
- Antifreeze
- Any item smaller than 2" in diameter or containers larger than a 5-gallon bucket
- Any material with food debris
- Asbestos
- Barrels
- Batteries of any kind
- Chemical products
- Coat hangers, wire
- Computers
- Contaminated oils (mixed with solvents, gasoline, etc)
- Dirt
- Glass jars or bottles
- Fluorescent tubes
- Food Waste
- Herbicides & pesticides
- Holiday lights
- Household items such as toasters, cookware, bake ware, electronics, appliances, etc
- Industrial waste
- Items containing or having debris and residue containing hazardous or toxic substances such as paint cans with wet paint, motor oil containers, gasoline cans, glue, petroleum products, etc
- Light bulbs
- Lubricating/hydraulic oil
- Medical waste
- Microwaves
- Mirrors, window or auto glass, porcelain, ceramics, glass cookware/bake ware, microwave oven trays, drinking glasses, perfume/cologne bottles
- Monitors
- Motor oil
- Oil filters
- Other flammable liquids
- Petroleum-contaminated soil/lead paint chips
- Plastic bags or films of any kind
- Political campaign signs
- Polystyrene foam, foam cups, dinnerware, packing foam or peanuts, etc of any kind
- Propane tanks
- Radioactive material
- Railroad ties
- Rubber hoses
- Solvents
- Televisions
- Tires
- Transmission oil
- Unnumbered plastics
- VHS/Cassette tapes and ribbon
- Wood or yard waste
- Wrapping ribbon

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- All glass containers must be empty and free of metal caps and rings and contain less than 5% food debris.
- All tin cans, bi-metal cans, and aluminum cans must be empty and contain less than 5% food debris.
- All aerosol cans must be empty with less than 5% content
- All plastic containers must be empty, caps removed; less than 5% food debris.
- All Fiber must be dry and free of food debris and other contaminating material.
- Tissues, paper towels or other paper that has been in contact with food is not acceptable.
